

**KOCHVILLE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEE
SPECIAL MEETING WORKSHOP WITH DAVIS ROAD RESIDENTS
MINUTES OF
November 21, 2016**

The Special Meeting Workshop started at 5:30 p.m. at the Kochville Veterans Hall.


Jeff Zittel introduced himself and explained the reason for the workshop which is to inform the residents along Davis Road about the status of the water line replacement on Davis Road from Kochville Road to Pierce Road. Jeff stated Kochville representatives had a meeting with the City of Saginaw on September 8th, 2016. Kochville was told they would receive a copy of the letter that was sent to Davis Road residents. Kochville Township has yet to receive such a letter. Kochville requested to be give copies of any existing contracts the City of Saginaw has with current City of Saginaw Davis Road water customers. Kochville Township has not received any copies yet. Supervisor Loiacano stated that Kochville Township has not received any more information from the City of Saginaw since the meeting on September 8th. Jeff stated that the Saginaw County Road Commission applied for a Grant to replace Davis Road but does not want to proceed until the water lines are to be replaced because of the 2 existing water mains are very shallow and any work could possibly damage the lines. The Road Commission has until November of 2017 to submit final paperwork for the grant.

DPW Manager Mike Comstock explained what water lines actually are that are running under Davis Road. One is an 48 inch untreated raw water line from Lake Huron and the other is 36 inch treated water line. Mike also asked any of the residents to give Kochville Township a copy of any contracts they have with the City of Saginaw. If they do he requested they give copies to either him or Jeff Zittel. Mike said there is a possibility that the existing lines under Davis Road may stay in place. The City of Saginaw has not made any final decisions yet as to what they are exactly going to do. There is also a possibility that the site of the water reservoirs on Kochville Road could be the location of the main treatment facility in the future. Residents were given a map by Mike that shows possible routing of new water lines. One resident asked if Kochville Township has any legal authority to stop the city of Sagianw? It is believed they do not.

After more discussion took place, Beverly Yanca asked what residents can do right now. Supervisor Loiacano stated that the residents need to submit a petition to request a water line to be installed on Davis Road. The paperwork can be obtained from Supervisor Loiacano.

Supervisor Loiacano stated that there would be an update of the status of this matter at the December 19, 2016 Regular Township Board Meeting.

Meeting adjourned at 6:19 pm.
